

User Scenarios

Scenario: Registered User

A registered user will have access to a profile page, which allows them access to past logs/records of harvests and locations. The registered user will also have the option to make the data they share “public” (for all eyes) or “private” (for their eyes and the scientist’s eyes). Users, guest or otherwise, will not be able to see “private” berry patches. This will protect against users “sharing their secret patches with everyone”. Users will have access to a map of available patches, a berry identification section, information on the fruitfly, a harvest form, and cultural uses of berries.

Scenario: Unregistered User or “Guest”

A guest user will have access to all functions, but will not have the option to register a patch as private or a log/record of their past entries. Guest users will have access to a map of available patches, a berry identification section, information on the fruitfly, a harvest form, and cultural uses of berries.
