


- This project is building off of the already existing Keweenaw Time Traveler website and codebase.

 order to find more relevant results for the user


Users


- *Scientists* -- Are studying the history of the Keweenaw area and are using this site as a resource and tool for research purposes. These users may also want to contribute to the data.


Instructional Content pt I

Potential Usability Concerns

- Steps might not be intuitive enough
- Error information might be inadequate
- New pop-up menus and pages might distract user from using the search tool
- Could be cases where too much information is available, especially with large amounts of people with same last names.
- Filters needing to be manually erased may not be obvious to user and may cause confusion
- Bio/story information will either be in the way of the map or hidden by the categories list

Current Implementation

- Allows for search, brings up results into separate categories from which the user can select to see more results if they desire.
- Removed the tabs for different kind of searches. Now there is only one search that calls the database for information.
- Filters have been added which will appear after a user as entered in a search term.
- There is now a help button which when clicked will give users information on how to perform a search.

Features to be implemented

- When an item is clicked on its separate information will be delegated to a pop-up.
- Combine all the php search scripts and make some edits in order to improve the functionality of the search.
- Include an instructional video in the help pop-up window.
- Fix bugs within the filter functionality.
