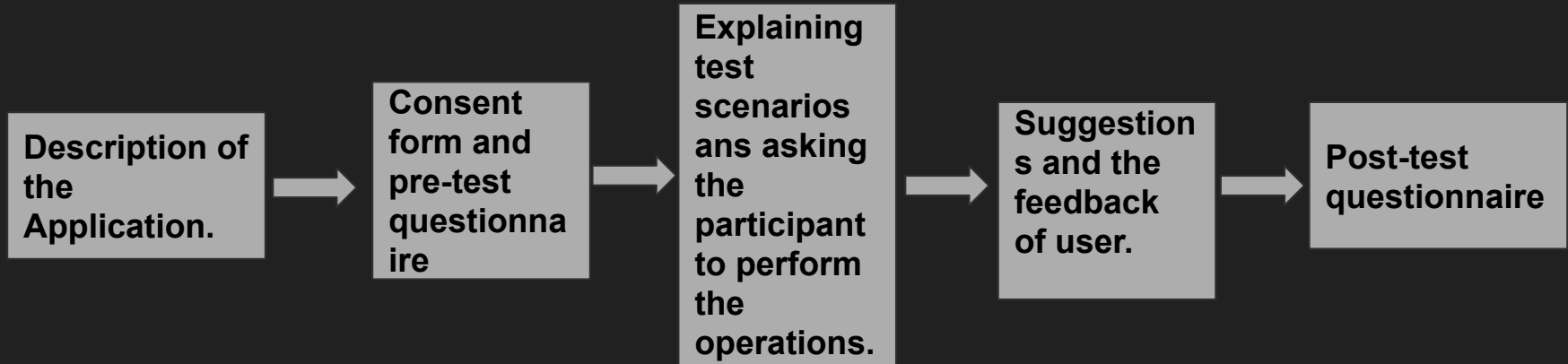
# Stream and Trail Application

- Normal User
  - a) Will use the mobile based web-application to check the trail condition.
  - b) The user will report the trail condition.
- Authenticated User
  - a) Will use the mobile based web-application to check the statistics and the trail condition.
  - b) The user can update the reported trail conditions, and can report the trail condition.
  - c) The user can upload and download the trail report.

# Main Motive of the Application

1. The user can be able to check the trail conditions before visiting the trail. If there is any problem in the trail, the user can report that in the application which alerts the trail managers.
2. The scientists/researchers can check the trail statistics and can upload and download the trail reports.

# Test Process

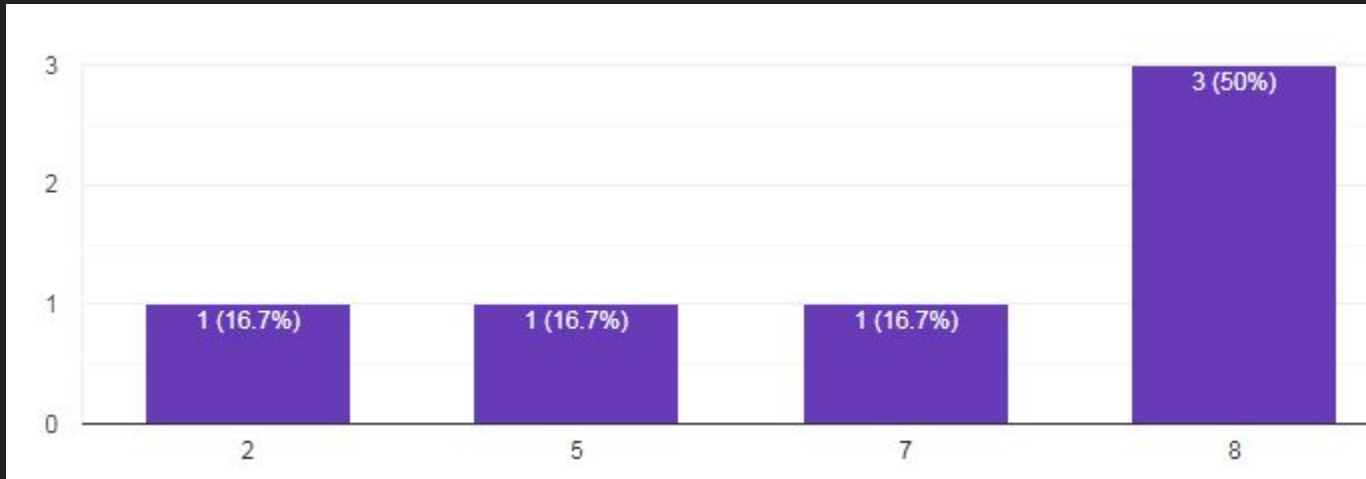


## Types of Data Collected

1. Time taken to complete each scenario.
2. Time taken for a participant to report the trail condition.
3. How each participant performed each task.
4. Number of questions asked.
5. How long to see the trail condition after the participant reported.
6. Suggestions and the feedback from participants.

- The upload and the download the report feature is not yet implemented because the report consists of the sensor data, the developers didn't have that sensor data.

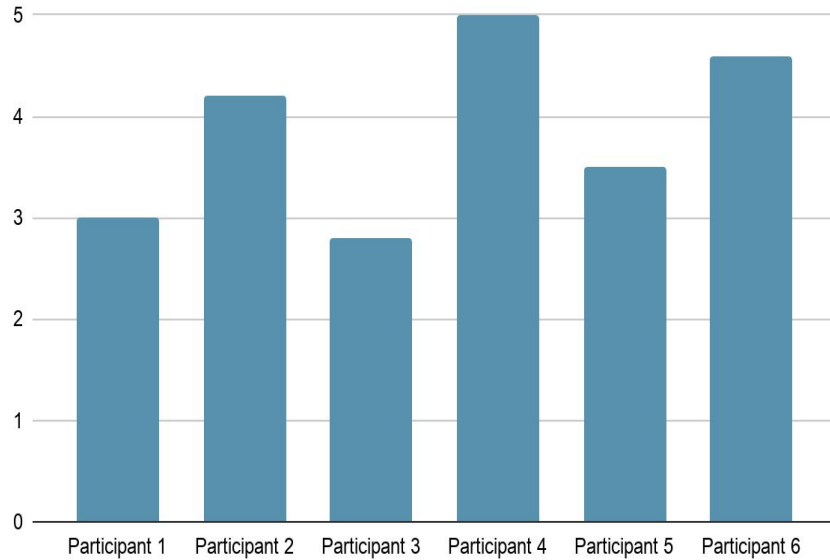


## **First Test Scenario: Exploring the basic features of the application as a Normal User.**

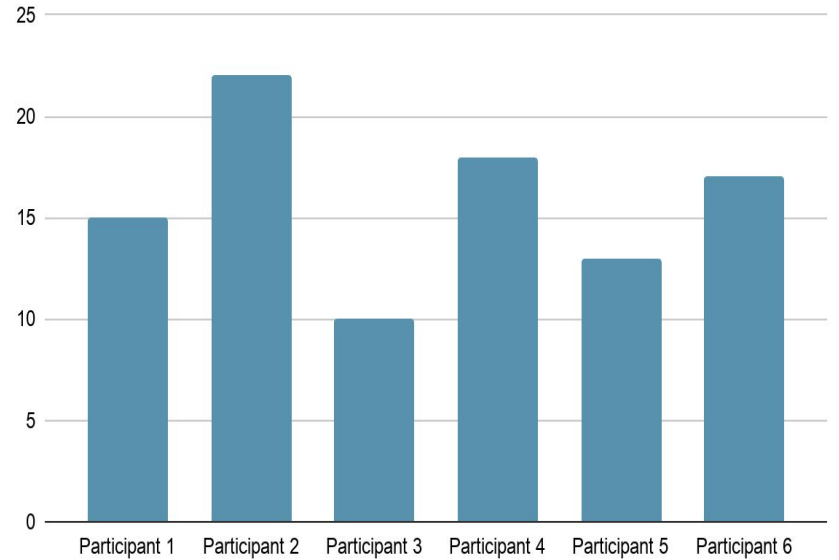
1. To check the trail condition in the home page.

Time taken to report the trail condition in seconds



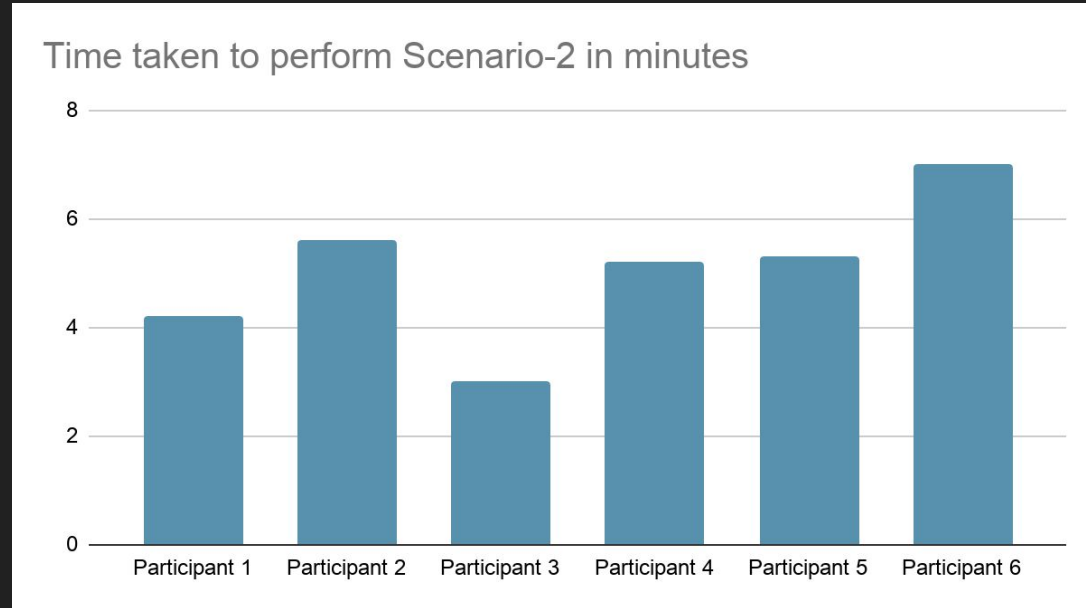
## **Second Test Scenario: Explore the basic features of the application as an Authenticated User.**

3. The user should be able to see the statistics of the trail conditions.

- The upload and the download report features in this scenario are not yet implemented.

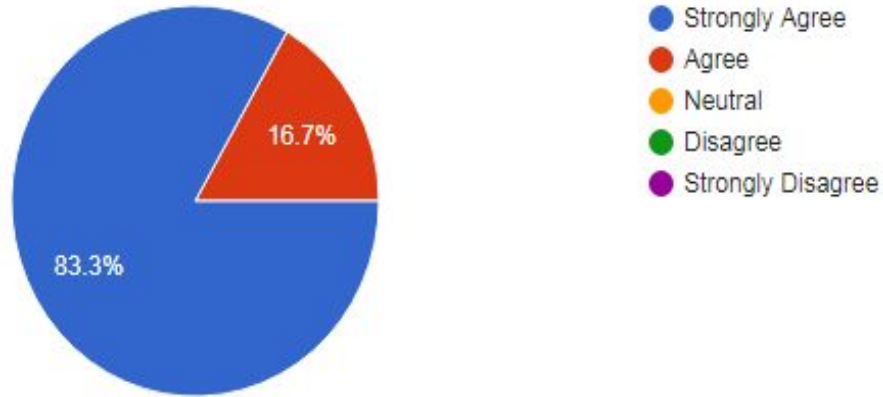


# Participants Feedback and Suggestions

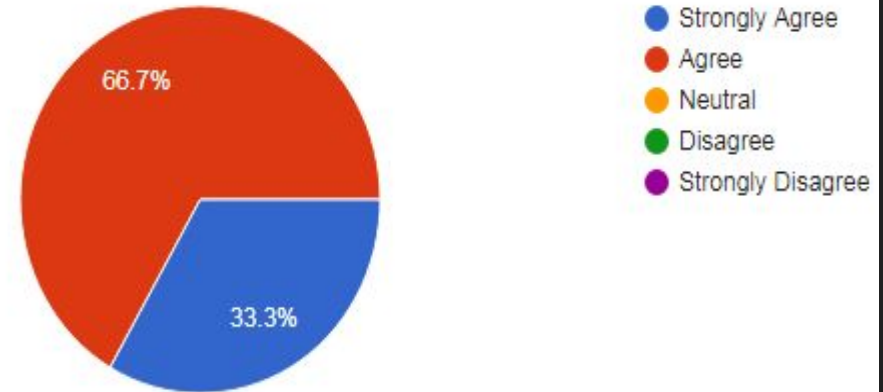
	<b>Like most about the application.</b>	<b>Suggestions for the improvement of the Application.</b>

- Overall this application was easy to perform the tasks.

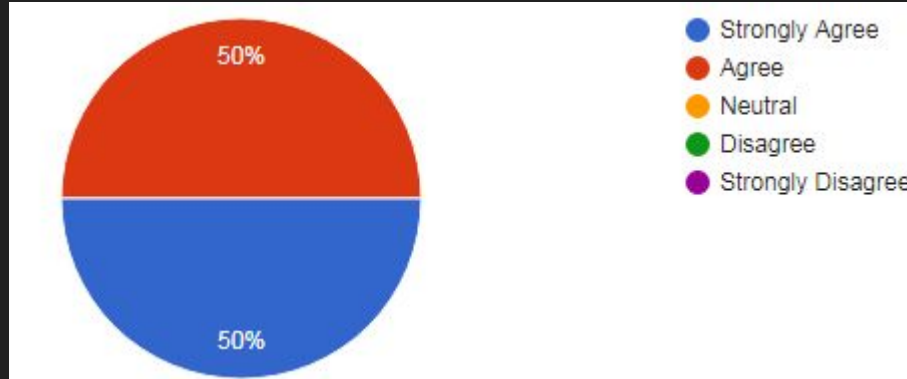

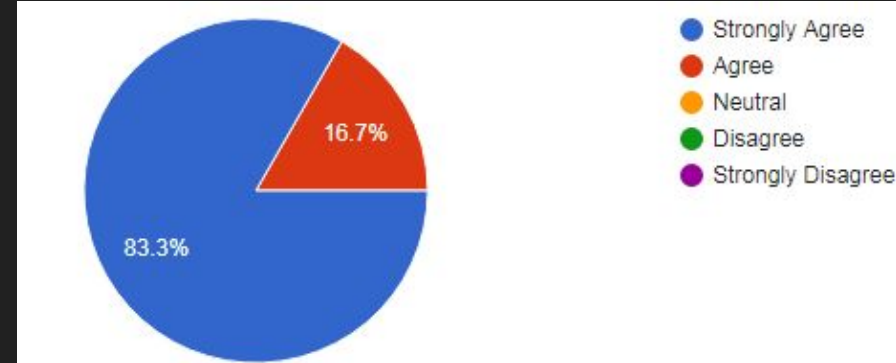


# Post-Test Questionnaire Results

- The buttons are clear and easily navigable.

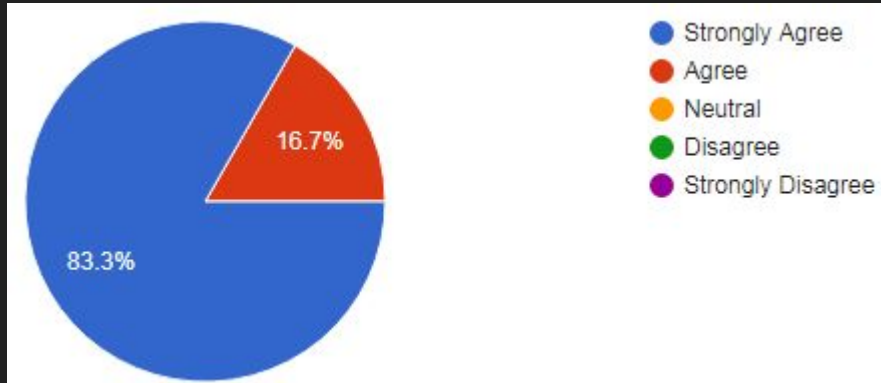


- The text was easy to read and understand.

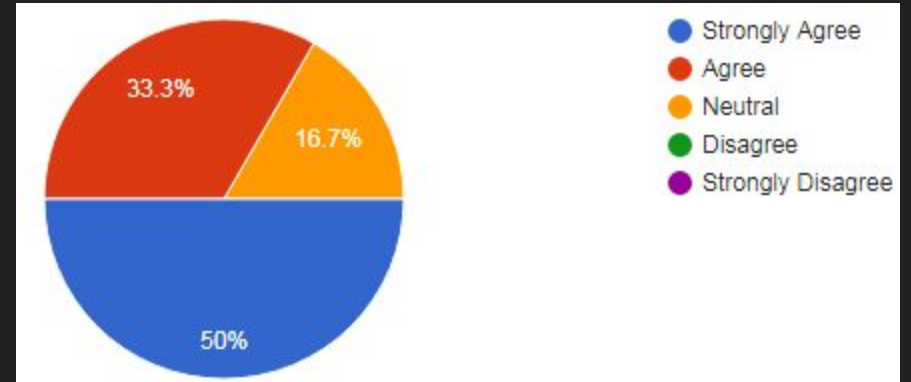


# Post-Test Questionnaire Results

# Bug Report Form

Bug Number	Bug Name	Bug Uniqueness	Bug Description
1	Error on trail reporting.	Once	Clicking on trail details then switching to a different trail directly (not all trails) then clicking add report will generate a 404 error
2	Report with the future date.	Sometimes	Overview tab gives incorrect number of reports in last 5 hours (one was in the future).
