

Design changes:

Change #1: Adding a help button next to each field. This will display a closable dialog that will display more information about the field the user needs to enter.

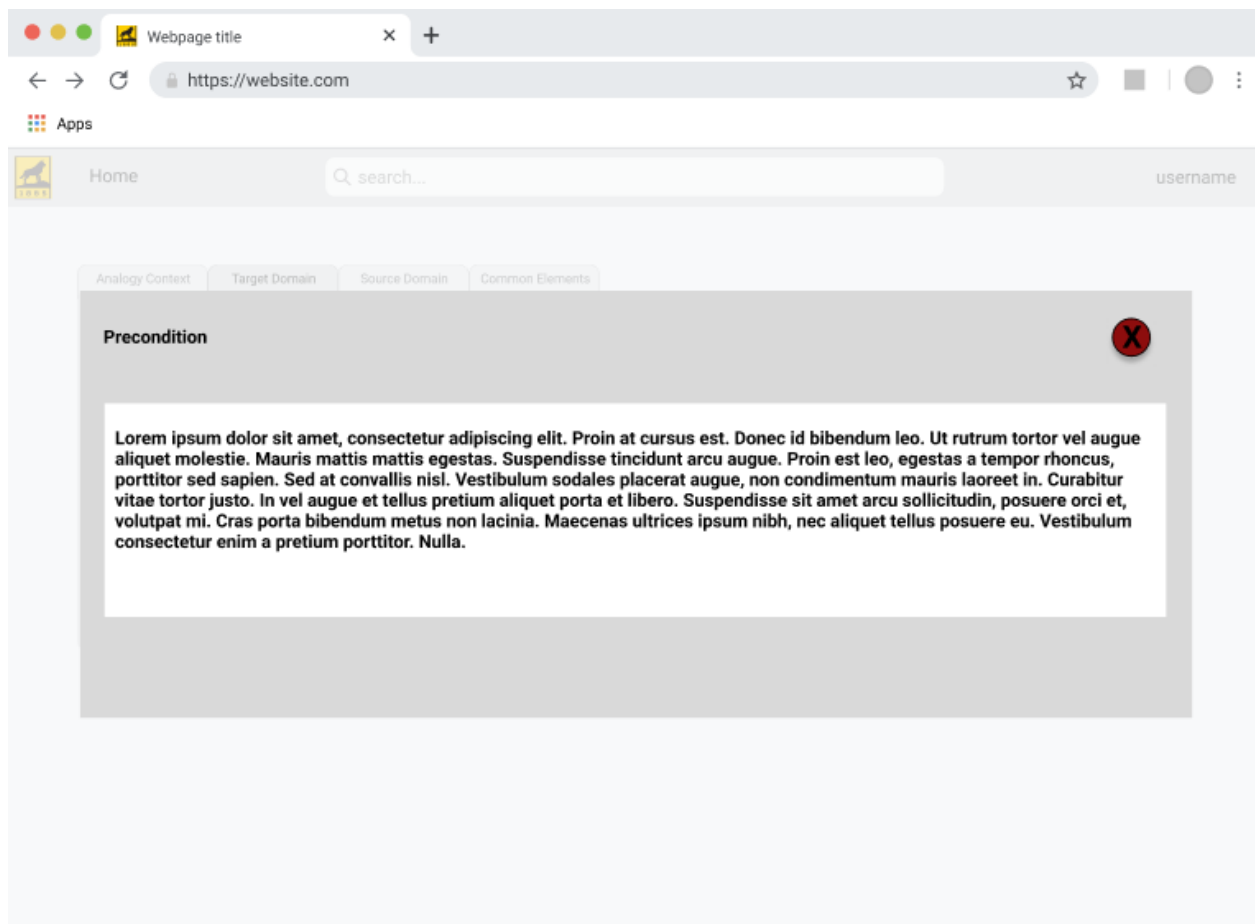
