Critiquing Group:

- 1. Q: How will we handle duplicated pictures and datapoints
 - A: Users would not be locked out from providing additional pictures or data, but it would be at the scientist's discretion to approve additional images of the same datapoint
- 2. Q: How will we deal with auditing large volumes of submissions
 - A: It will be at the discretion of the researcher to approve submissions
- 3. Q: Is there an explicit list of green space types when selecting
 - A: Yes, there is an explicit list of green space types for users to select from

Scientist Mary:

- 1. Q: Will you be able to make accounts anonymously
 - A: The end goal is to have every user under a username, but it can be completely detached from the real person.
- 2. Q: Will users be able to download the pictures on the website
 - A: Yes, they will be able to freely access the photos available on the website as well.

Pastel:

- 1. Q: Concerns regarding the number of different pages
 - A: Prioritize our pages better, maybe streamline them
- 2. Q: Concerns with the general UI design.
 - A: We will work together to get on the same page for the UI design colors and general template
- 3. Q: Are you getting the quizzes from the scientists/why is the quiz on another page A: No, we are creating them ourselves from education material and the quizzes will be located on the same page as the education material

UI/UX Concerns:

- 1. Q: Will there be flexibility for mobile devices
 - A: Yes, we are considering mobile device formats
- 2. Q: Why include the ability to categorize datapoints when users are likely to provide bad
 - A: The scientist will be able to use submission auditing to determine quality/usefulness
